

How to book your YFC Impact Holiday



1. Choose your holiday.
2. Fill in the form opposite.
Sign it yourself and if you are under 18 ask your parents/guardian to sign it too.
3. Get a cheque for £30 (made payable to Youth for Christ) as a non-refundable deposit and send it with the form to the "Apply to" person given in your holiday details. Mark envelope with the holiday name.
4. Make sure you book as early as possible – ideally by the end of February 2010. If late, check with the holiday leader that places are still available.

Then what happens?

You'll be told that your application form has been accepted within 4 weeks (if not contact the same person again). Later you'll be sent more details, such as what to bring and how to get there.

The rest of your holiday money (ie the total cost minus your £30 deposit) must be paid to your "Apply to" person 8 weeks before the holiday starts. See the "Contractual terms" over the page to find out what you will be liable for if you cancel your booking.

NOTE:

Costs – don't include the cost of travel (unless arranged separately by the holiday leader) and some optional activities may cost extra.

Leaders – costs for leaders are usually the same as those for young people. Leaders who are able to accompany their groups are very welcome!

Safety – certain specialist activities can only take place under qualified supervision. We make every effort to have suitable volunteers available, but YFC reserves the right to withdraw an activity if safety standards cannot be guaranteed. Where possible you will be notified in advance of the changes.

Insurance – All YFC holidays are covered by Public Liability Insurance. Please note that no Personal Accident or Personal Property Cover is included in the fees. A brochure about cover will be sent by your holiday leaders.

Contractual Terms

Upon the written acceptance of an application for a place on a venture, there will be an agreement between: Youth for Christ, Coombswood Way, Halesowen, West Midlands, B62 8BH ("YFC") and the applicant or the parent or the guardian of the applicant signing the form for the benefit of the applicant if the applicant is under 18 on the day when his or her application is accepted ("the applicant") in the following terms:

1. Subject to any changes notified to the applicant before written acceptance of an application is sent to the applicant, YFC agree to provide full board and accommodation at the location and for the period described in the YFC Holiday Brochure 2010 ("the brochure") for the venture in respect of which the applicant has been accepted ("the venture"), commencing with the evening meal on the day of which the venture begins and ending with breakfast on the day on which the venture ends, for the price specified in the brochure (all such accommodation will comply with the law of the country in which it is situated).
2. YFC agree to provide the activities described in the brochure in relation to the venture, although there is no guarantee that every applicant accepted on a venture will be able to participate in all the activities so described. Certain specialist activities can only take place under qualified supervision. While every effort will be made to have suitable volunteers available, YFC reserve the right to withdraw an activity if safety standards cannot be guaranteed. Where possible the applicant will be notified in advance of any such change.
3. The applicant agrees to pay YFC by cheque (or other money order) made out in favour of "Youth for Christ" (or "AquaSports" for the AquaSports holiday) for the total price stated for the venture in the brochure less the initial deposit sent with the application form ("the balance"). The balance should be sent not less than eight weeks before the venture is due to begin. It shall be sent to the Applications Secretary of the venture named in the brochure ("the secretary") unless other directions for payments are given by YFC or the leader of the venture ("authorised agent"). In the event of non-payment by the due date, YFC or their authorised agent may terminate the agreement with immediate effect.
4. The applicant may cancel a place on a venture by notifying YFC or their authorised agent in writing any time before the balance becomes payable. In the event of such cancellation, the deposit will be forfeited. If the applicant wishes to cancel a place on a venture on or after the date when the balance becomes payable, the applicant remains liable for 50% of the full fees if less than six weeks notice in writing is given, and 75% if less than three weeks notice in writing is given. Cancellation on or after the commencement date of the venture means the applicant is liable for full fees.
5. YFC may cancel the venture if: the minimum number of members required for the venture have not applied for places ten weeks before the venture is due to begin, provided that the applicant is notified of such a cancellation not less than eight weeks before the venture is due to begin; or unusual and unforeseen circumstances arise which are beyond YFC's control. In the event of such cancellation YFC agree to return the applicant any fees already paid.
6. YFC will provide leaders and other voluntary workers on the venture who will exercise reasonable care in looking after the applicant.
7. During the venture the applicant agrees to co-operate with the leaders and any other person in authority on the venture. In the event of the applicant causing injury to any other person or damage to any property or being wilfully disobedient at any time during the venture, reasonable discipline will be exercised as is considered to be appropriate.
8. In the event of a serious incident, YFC or their authorised agent may terminate the agreement with immediate effect. In the event of their agreement being terminated the parent or guardian shall, upon being notified of the termination, at their own expense collect the applicant or make such arrangements as are necessary to remove the applicant from the venture site as soon as practically possible.
9. In the event of the applicant suffering loss or damage (other than personal injury) for which compensation is payable by reason of the non-performance or improper performance of the agreement, the amount of compensation shall be negotiable and, in any event, shall be limited to the price of the venture.
10. The agreement is subject to the implied terms, conditions and warranties stipulated and the liability imposed by the Package Travel, Package Holidays and Package Tours Regulations 1992 ("the regulations"). Save as provided by the regulations, YFC shall not be liable to compensate the applicant in respect of any breach of the terms of the agreement.
11. In the event of the applicant suffering loss or damage while the applicant is being carried by sea by reasons of the non-performance or improper performance of the agreement, the amount of any compensation payable shall be limited to the amount specified in the Athens Convention of 1974 on the Carriage by Sea.
